

# PANAMA

## Requirements

The following documents and information are required for filing a trademark application in Panama:

- 1 Applicant's name, nationality, and full address.
- 2 Labels (preferably) in an electronic format or 25 labels with a size of 8 x 8 cms.
- 3 Specific list of goods or services sought to be protected by the application per class.
- 4 Power of Attorney document signed for an authorized officer of the company, before Notary Public, which must certify the legal existence of the company, as well as the ability of the person who signs this document. This document must be legalized by the Panamanian Consulate, or through the Apostille, according to the Hague Convention. This document may be filed along with the application or during the following 30 days after filing.
- 5 Priority document: A certified copy of the application from which the priority rights are claimed. This document may be filed along with the application or during the following 3 months after filing.
